Biography of M. Ex. Comp. Jack Heinz

Jack Heinz was born North of Gladstone in the Glenella-Walderees area. In 1951 he moved to Snow Lake and then in 1955 he moved to Flin Flon. Shortly after that we pick up his Masonic history when he was initiated into Masonry on Jan 21, 1969, and received his Fellowcraft degree on March 29, followed shortly thereafter with his Master Masons degree on April 15, 1969.

He then entered Royal Arch Masonry on April 24th, 1971. Became First Principal of Chapter #17 in 1984. He was elected Grand J at our 1986 Convocation.

In private avocation Jack was employed as Recreational Director while in Snow Lake. When he moved to Flin Flon, Jack operated a large General/Life Insurance Agency. He retired from active business pursuits in 1980.
